

Brookville Trail Hub

Minutes July 8, 2024

The meeting was called to order by President Paul Boboige at 6:30 PM at the Brookville YMCA. Attending in person were Paul Boboige, David Richards, Terry Borden, and Wendy Belfiore. There were no remote attendees.

Secretary's Report: Dave Richards presented the minutes of the May 13, 2024 meeting. Terry Borden motioned to approve. Paul Boboige seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Acting Treasurer Paul Boboige presented the Treasurer's Report. As of June 30, 2024 the checking account balance was \$7,263.98. Expenses were \$60.64 for sixteen signs. Remaining funds from the signage and beautification grant are \$646.09. Wendy Belfiore motioned to approve the treasurer's report. Terry Borden seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business: Possible signs for the trail include a general history of the Pittsburg & Shawmut Railroad. Paul Boboige has a passenger timetable that can be included. Another option is a sign regarding birds along the trail.

The grant from the Jefferson County Tourism agency is finalized. PA On Display brochures are "sold out"

Paul Boboige completed a grant request for the trail consultant to justify the trail transfer from Tricounty Trails to the Brookville Trail Hub. Paul gave the grant request to Sandy from Tricounty Trails to officially file.

The 10K Event discussion was tabled until the August meeting. If details are not clearly defined by the August meeting, the event will need to be cancelled for this year.

Maintenance Report: The trail was sprayed, and drainage improved in several locations. At least one tri-axel load of stone is needed immediately to fill soft areas of the trail. Only one bridge remains to be stained. Brush cutting continues and is needed in several locations.

New Business: The parking sign has been placed on Arch Street Extension.

A discussion was held on using a trail cam to capture unauthorized ATV and side by side users on the trail. No decision was reached.

A discussion was held on appointing Honorary Board Members. These members would have authority over specific trail interests such as Information Technology. No specific decision was reached.
